I would like to discuss our classes website project, Mr. Schrader's Classroom located at <http://sites.google.com/site/schrader>. This site is intended to serve multiple purposes, and I hope to describe those here.

The goal of this site is to enhance parent, student, and teacher communication, improve student writing, introduce technology, and give information for each subject we study, including spelling words, homework, and projects. We are a very busy class, and this site should reflect those activities we do.

There are several areas of the site that may be of interest. First, it may be used as a tool for you, the parents. It will have our daily assignment agenda on it, a copy of our classroom policies, and it will have a copy of our weekly newsletter with information on what we are studying in school.
